4. **Macro Explorer** – this innovative app helps you explore and identify global economic trends, areas of risk and investment opportunities using macroeconomic and aggregated equity data across a range of visualizations, including a world map and sector heat map.
5. **Economic Events Monitor** provides a real-time global view on all macroeconomic announcements in a simple calendar interface. It includes Reuters economic polls so you can track market expectations concerning foreign exchange rates, macroeconomic indicators and more.

Search

Use Eikon's search box to find apps, data and answers to your questions

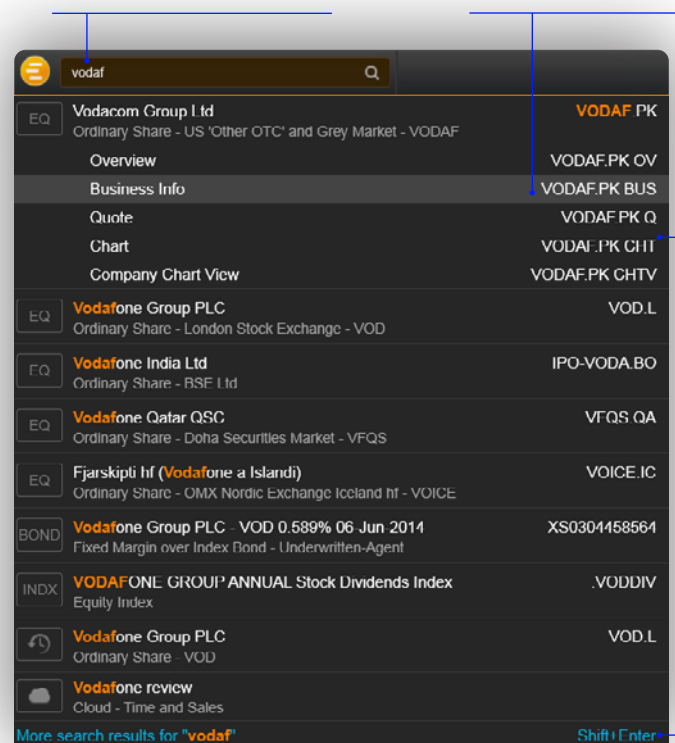
- Eikon provides highly intuitive search through auto-suggest and natural language search. For example, search **Ford vs GM sales** to display a comparison view of the sales for these two stocks
- Search across asset classes
- Includes greater private company coverage
- Datastream's powerful Navigator search tool is of course still available too, via the Datastream apps in the Eikon desktop and Eikon for Microsoft Office

3. Click a result to load content. For example, you can open the Chart app with data for Vodafone already loaded.

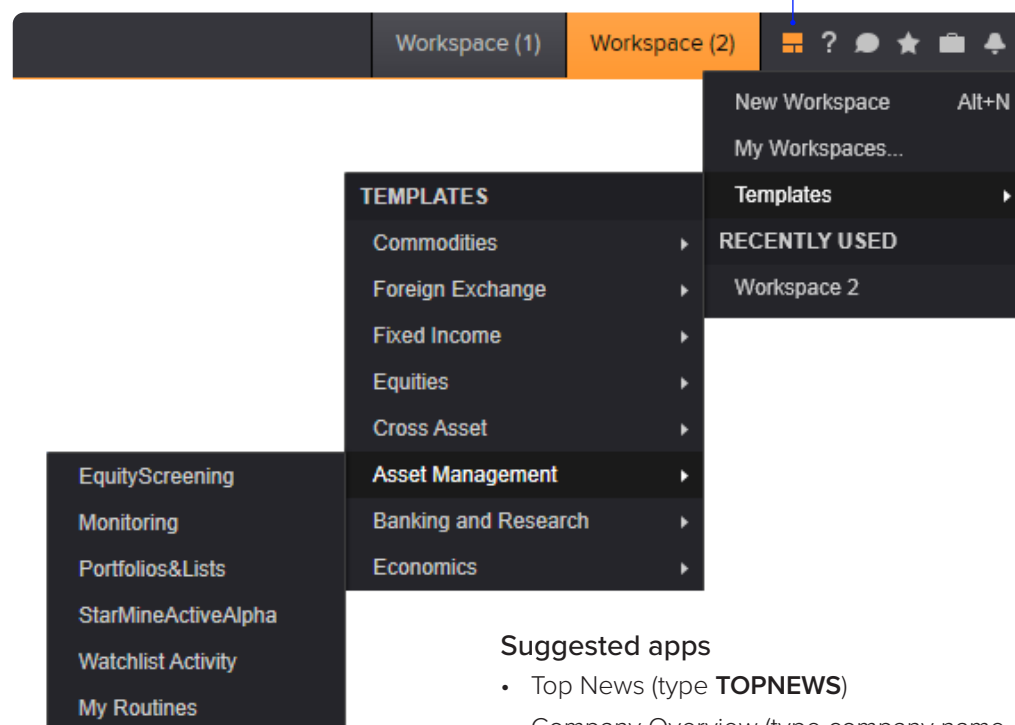
4. If you don't find what you are looking for, press **Shift + Enter** or click here to run an advanced search.

Workflow – linking views in a workspace

To access, launch Microsoft Excel® and log in using the Refinitiv tab

Create a new workspace

Click here (top right toolbar) to create new workspaces or open sample templates.



Suggested apps

- Top News (type **TOPNEWS**)
- Company Overview (type company name or code and **OV**, e.g., **Apple OV**)
- Industry Overviews (type **INDUS**)
- Country Overviews (type country name)
- Search (type **search**)
- Screener (type **screener**)

Add apps to your workspace

When you open an app by selecting it in the app menu, the app library, or through the search box, it automatically becomes part of your active workspace.

This example includes a quote list, Option Watch and News Monitor.

The active symbol (in this case, Renault <RENA.PA>) is the most recent financial instrument you have focused on. When you add an app, it automatically displays data for the active symbol.



Click an app title bar to move the app. Click and slowly drag an app until its frame touches another app: the two apps "snap" together, and you can move them around as a single entity.

Resize an app as you would any other window: just click the frame and drag to the new size.

Add News Monitor to your workspace to get:

- The latest market-moving news
- Historical news archives
- Feature-rich, intuitive user interface

Workflow – linking views in a workspace

Then link the apps together

You can link apps together so that they share the content of your chosen instruments. Color-coded apps “tune in” to the same data.

1. This example includes a quote list, news and a Company Overview page.
2. In the top left of each app, click to choose a color. In this case, all three apps are linked with red.
3. Now that the apps are linked, type a new instrument code into any app. All other apps will automatically display content for the new instrument.

Tip: when you snap apps together, if one is already tuned to a color, the other one links to the same color.

Share with colleagues

After creating your workspace, you can save it for later use or share it with colleagues. Right-click on the workspace and select **Share** to send to a colleague using Messenger. More details on this collaboration tool can be found in the additional benefits section on page 24.



Working in Microsoft Office

To access, launch Excel and log in using the Refinitiv tab

- Eikon includes a suite of Datastream capabilities which are integrated as apps within the Eikon desktop and Microsoft Office
- The new add-in offers additional content including real-time pricing, detailed estimates, ownership data and StarMine Quantitative Analytics – all retrieved using a simple wizard
- You can also quickly integrate your portfolios and lists into your Excel models
- Simply drag and drop or export content from Eikon to Excel, where it will update dynamically
- Other advantages over the Analysis for Office add-in include:
 - Formula-based requests which can be integrated with Excel formulas, rather than ActiveX controls
 - An enhanced expression-building interface including extended character limits
 - Series suggest/type ahead functionality within the request window, for faster search
 - Support for RIC
 - Improved support for cell referencing and auto refresh
 - Integration with the Eikon desktop via right-click to relevant views, e.g., news
 - Keyboard shortcuts for routine tasks
 - Screening and portfolio management tools built in
 - HTTP communications which allow you to connect on the go using Wi-Fi

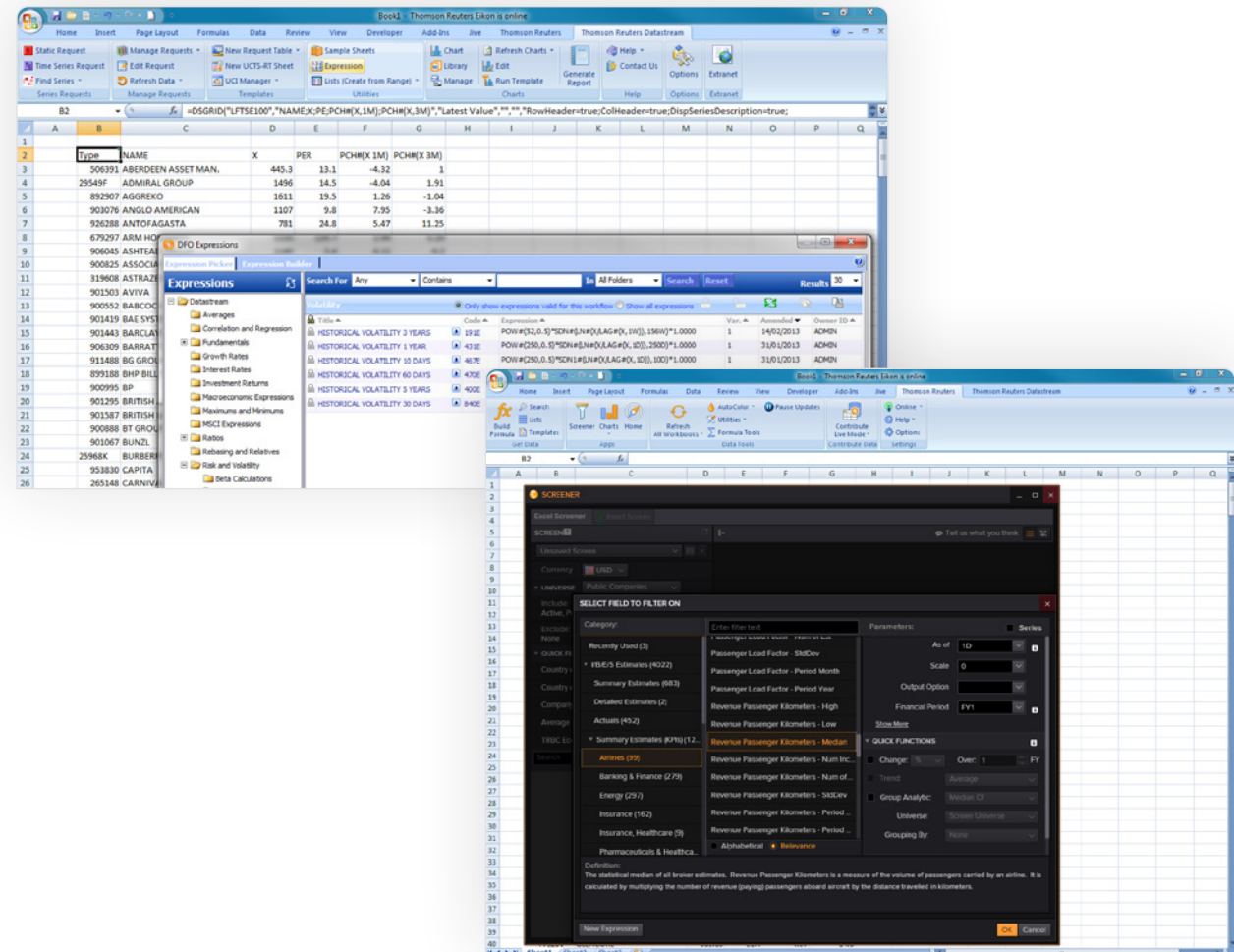


Chart organization/library (ex-projects)

Save charts in your Datastream Charting library – search **DATASTREAM LIBRARY** or type **DSLIB**

- Datastream charts can be saved in your library in a user-defined order and/or exported and saved in Microsoft Office applications
- Organize your Datastream charts into user-friendly, user-defined folders, subfolders and collections in the user library. These libraries are stored and hosted on Refinitiv servers, helping you avoid the risk of losing them
- You can also export charts in bulk to Microsoft Office files locally and save workspaces in Eikon containing Datastream charts and other content
- You can choose to share your charts with your colleagues by saving them into a shared folder, or keep them hidden in your private folder

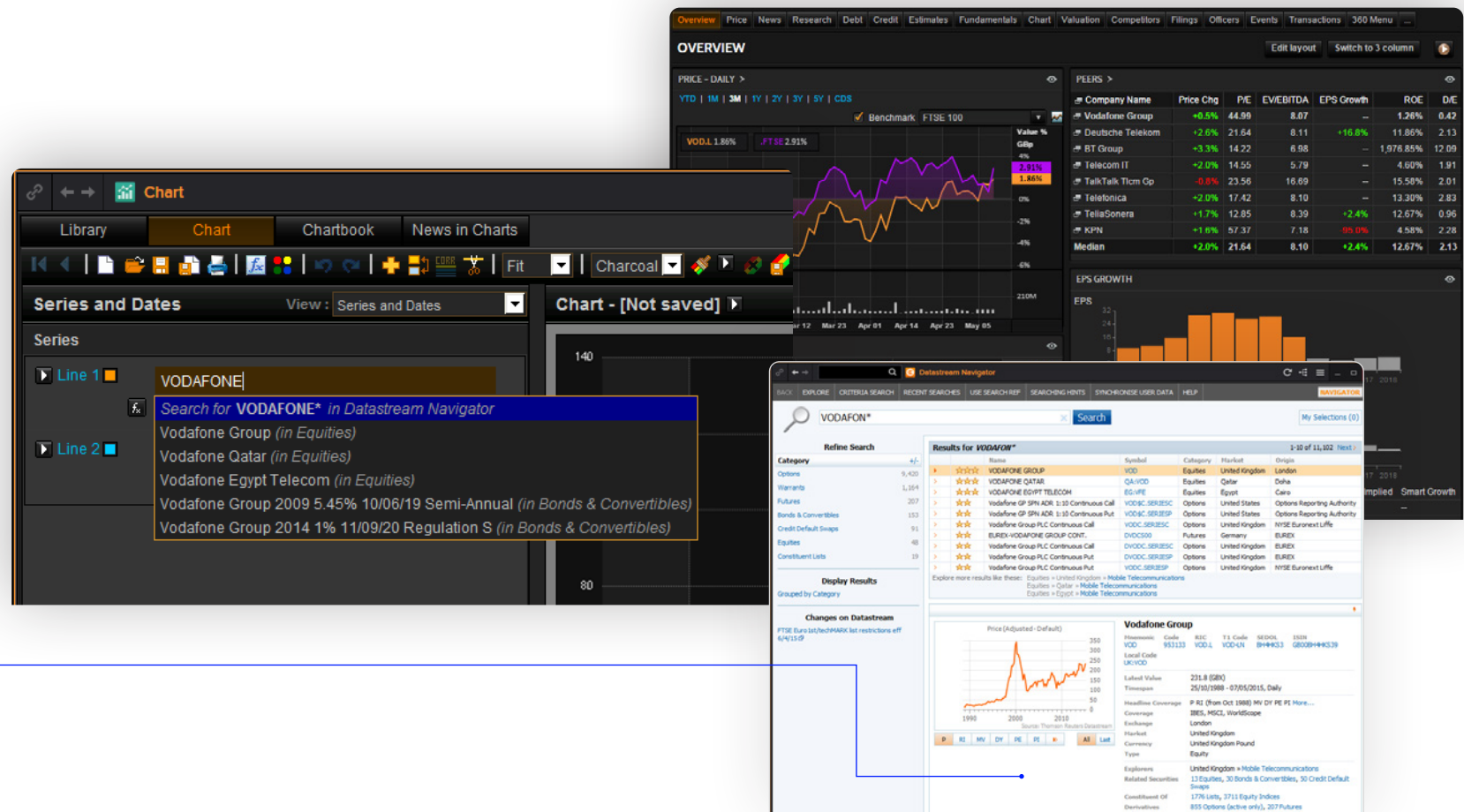

Overviews

For Company Overview pages, search on company name or code and select **OVERVIEW**.
Datastream Navigator also provides summary metadata and quick charts in its Spotlight panel

- Eikon's Company Overview pages provide a wide range of company-related information in one highly customizable landing page that you can tailor to your needs
- Overview pages include a business description, news, significant developments, events, fundamentals, estimates and recommendations, plus StarMine-related bullish and bearish model information
- Datastream Navigator provides dynamic links to related securities, peers, indices and constituent lists, plus additional notes such as business descriptions for equities or source notes from third-party economic data providers



Datastream Chart Studio

- The Datastream Chart Studio in Eikon provides an improved and modernized look and feel for chart creation
- Includes full editing, customization and publishing capabilities, plus sophisticated analytical tools such as slicing of multiple time periods, optimal correlation of lines and multiple regression
- Access an extensive library of example charts and pre-built topical charts from renowned economists in the chartbook

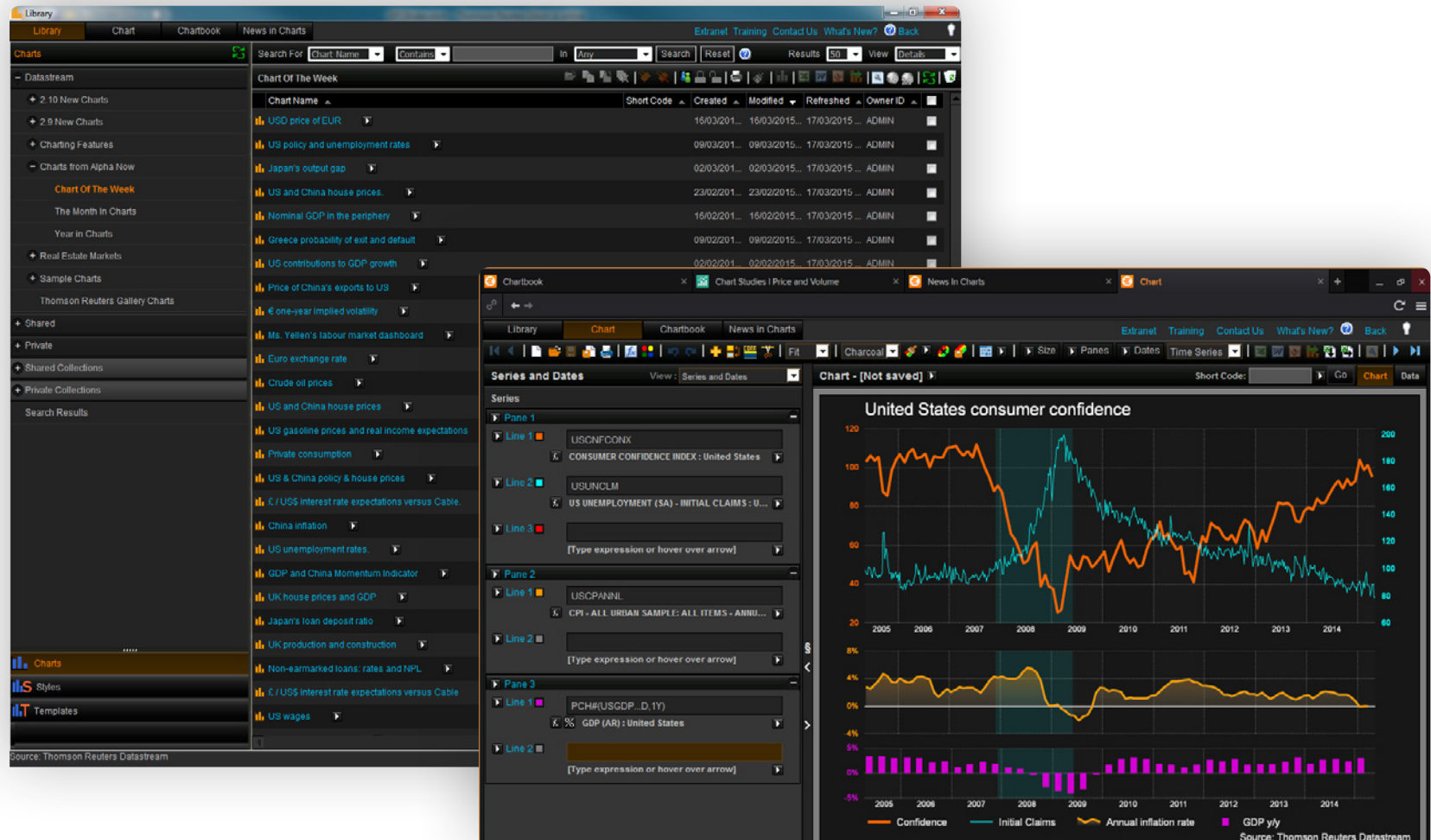
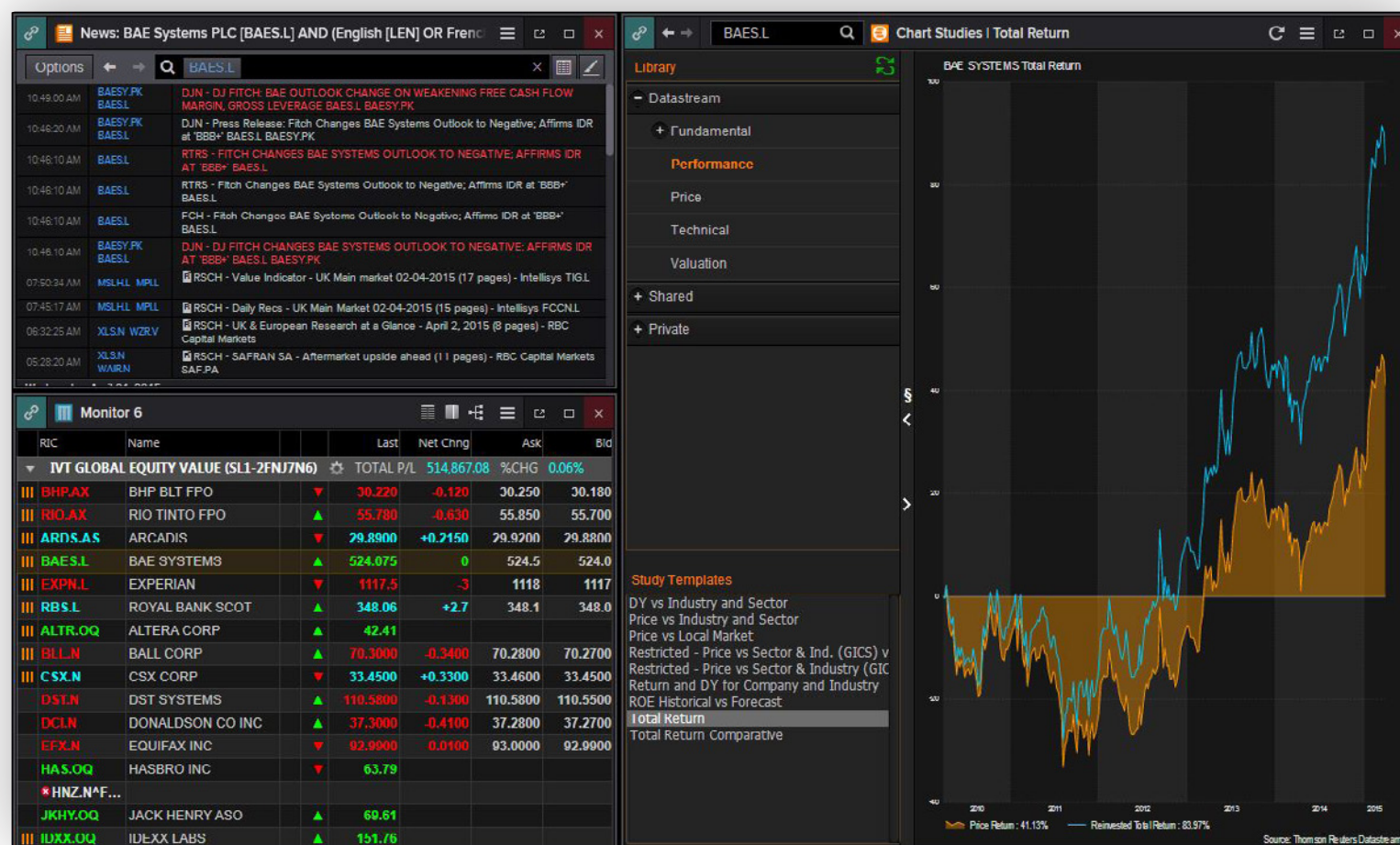


Chart studies

To access, type the company name or code followed by **CHART STUDIES** or right-click an equity symbol and choose **Related > Datastream**

- Quick and easy access to a wide variety of pre-built charts, grouped into categories for fundamentals, performance, valuation and technical analysis
- Link news, prices and charts together so you can quickly cycle through a list of securities (see page 6 for linking apps)
- All chart studies can be displayed for the time period of your choice – and can be fully customized and published using the sophisticated tools available in Datastream Charting



PE Bands

To access, type the company name or code and **PEBANDS**

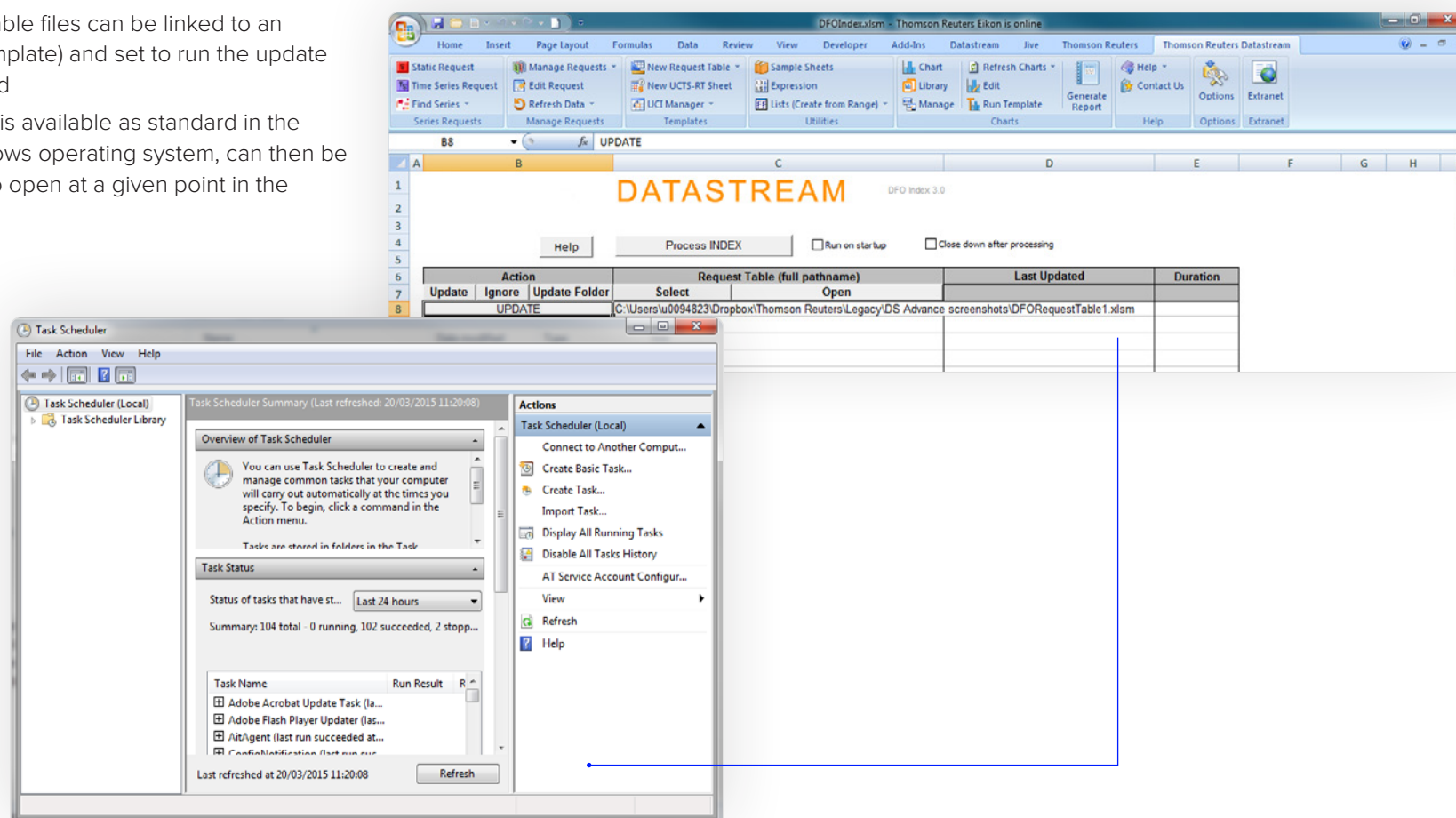
- PE Bands help you to visualize a company's performance relative to its historical valuation
- Two versions are available: fixed multiples of earnings (1X, 10X, 20X, 30X, 40X) or dynamically placed bands according to the maximum and minimum PE over the period
- PE Bands are conveniently available alongside a range of other chart studies



Automating and scheduling index files downloads

Use Windows Task Scheduler with the Datastream index file templates

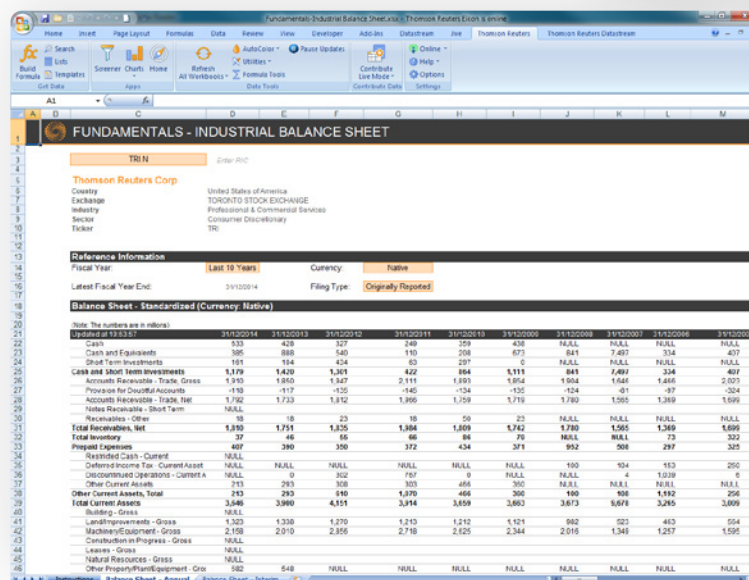
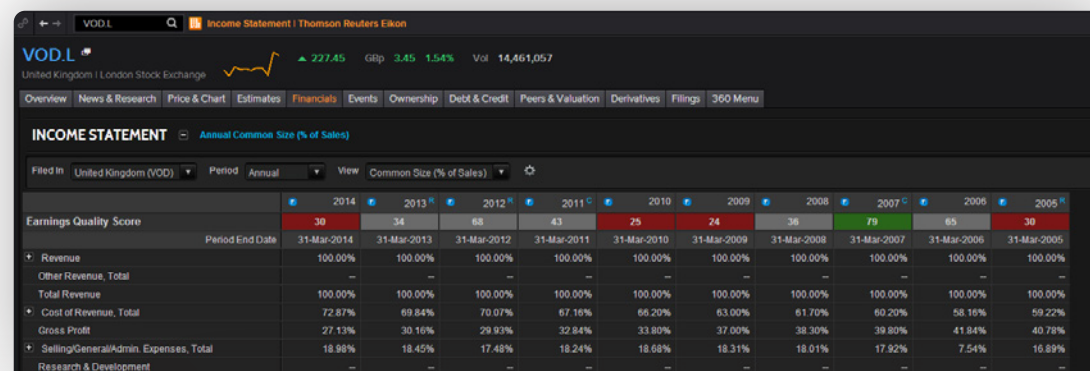
- Datastream charts and request table files can be linked to an index file (a Datastream Excel template) and set to run the update download when the file is opened
- The Task Scheduler utility, which is available as standard in the Accessories section of the Windows operating system, can then be used to schedule the index file to open at a given point in the future (e.g., overnight)



Company accounts data (fundamentals)

Type the company code or name followed by **INC** (income statement), **BAL** (balance sheet) or **CF** (cash flow)

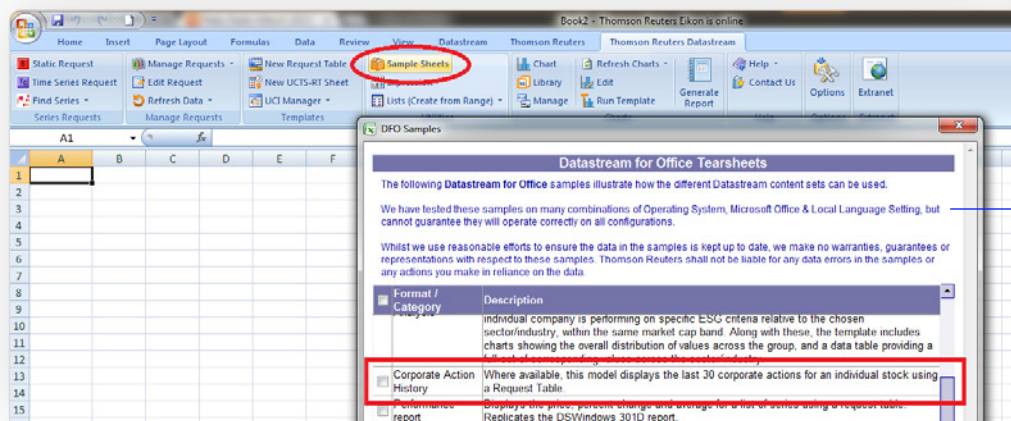
- Access fundamentals including:
 - Income statement, balance sheet and cash flow
 - Operating metrics, segments and major customers
 - Ratios and earnings quality
- Refinitiv® Worldscope datatypes can be downloaded for lists of stocks using yearly frequency time series requests
- Pre-built Excel files for balance sheets, income statements and cash flow statements are available via the Templates button on the Refinitiv tab in Excel



Capital issues and changes (corporate actions)

Type the company name or code followed by **corporate actions**, or utilize the Datastream add-in's templates and datatypes

- The Eikon corporate actions calendar allows you to review historical corporate actions which have resulted in price adjustments (capital change, dividends, mergers and acquisitions, bond issuance, dividends, etc.)
- Data can be combined within existing Excel models and files (versus the standalone report in Datastream Advance)
- For the corporate action Datastream for Office (DFO) sample sheet, go to the Datastream tab and select **sample sheets** and **corporate actions history template**

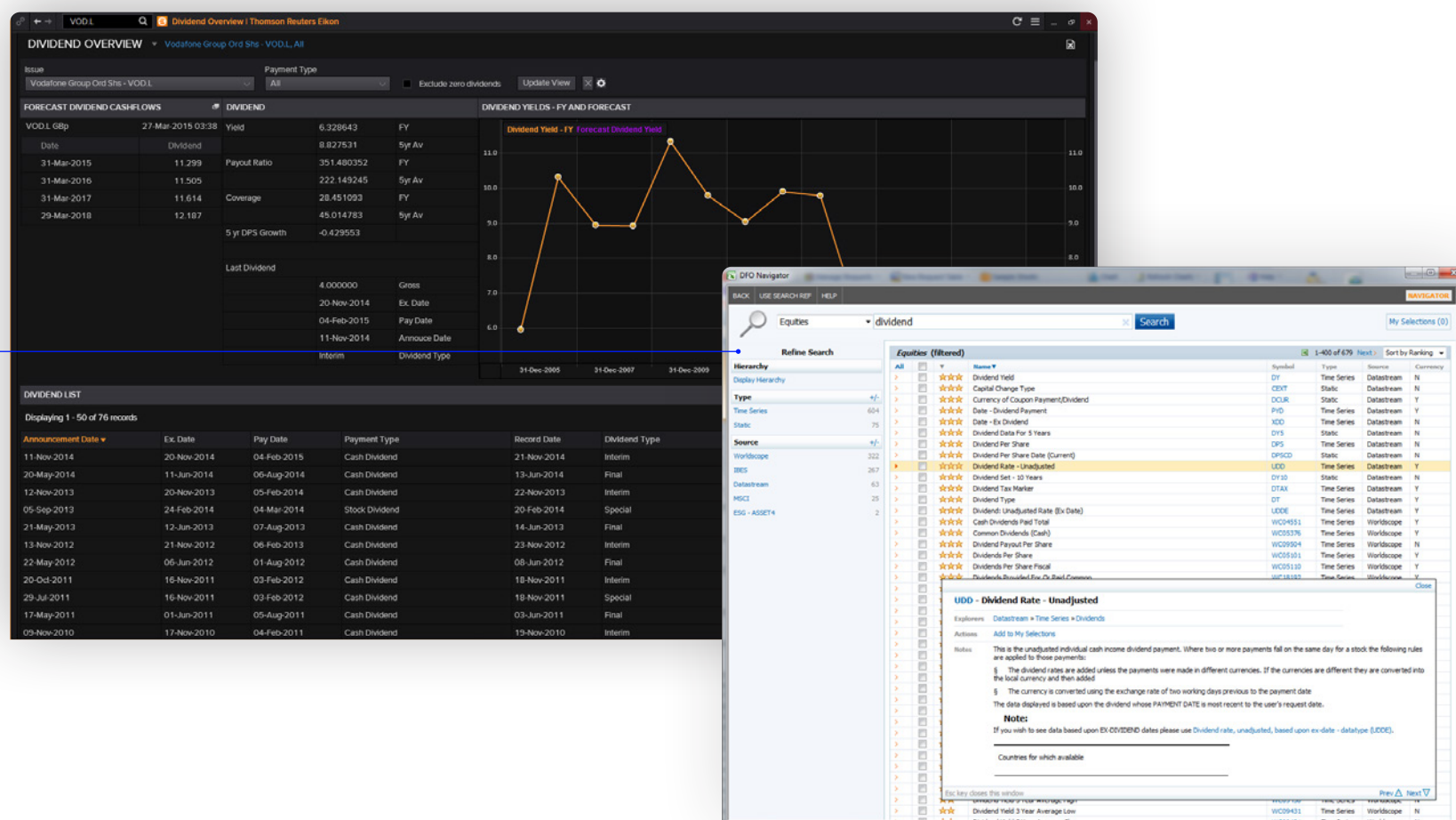

Dividend payment report

Type the company name or code and **dividends** and select **Dividend Overview**, or use the Datastream add-in to choose from a selection of relevant datatypes in Excel

- The Dividend Overview report displays dividend payment history, current and forecasted dividend yields (in chart format), payout ratios, coverage and forecasted dividend cash flows
- The dividend payment detail view shows net/gross dividend ex-date and pay date
- Data can be combined into Excel as well, using the preformatted corporate actions template request in Excel



Detailed estimates

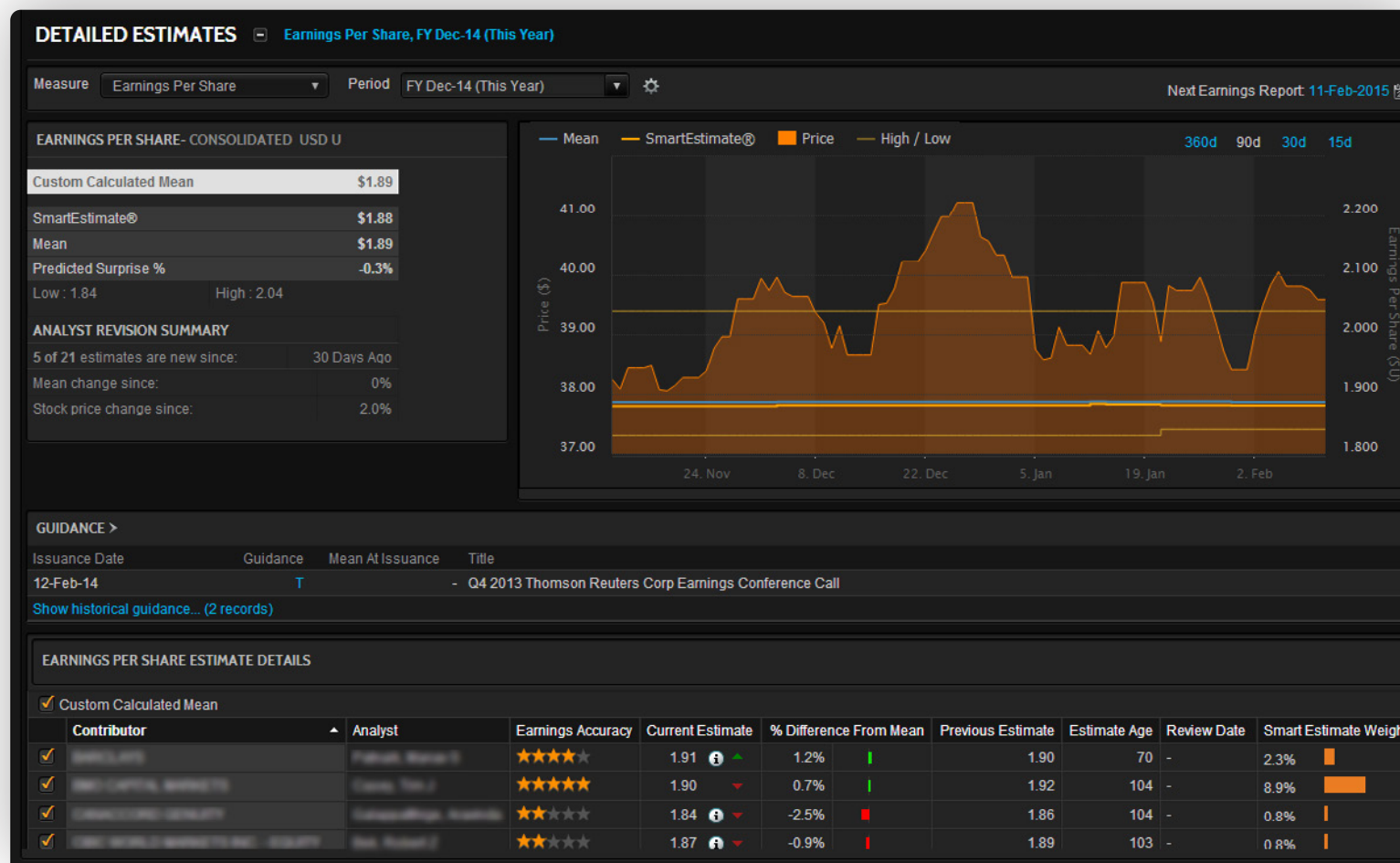
To access, type the company code or name followed by **ESTD**, then select **Estimates** from the drop-down menu for additional views

- Break out each measure by broker to see the underlying detail, for a single period or full year
- Eikon offers more measures, a vastly superior chart view, plus Refinitiv® SmartEstimates® (see below) and red and green indicators showing deviation from the mean

Industry-specific metrics

- Perform in-depth peer group analyses with industry-specific performance indicators
- Access 192 key metrics across airlines, banking and finance, energy and mining, insurance, pharmaceuticals and healthcare, real estate, hotels and homebuilders, retail and restaurants, and technology and telecommunications

The Predicted Surprise is the percentage difference between the SmartEstimate and the I/B/E/S consensus estimate. When SmartEstimates diverge significantly from the consensus, it serves as a leading indicator of the direction of future revisions and/or surprises. In aggregate, this indicator gets earnings surprises directionally correct 70% of the time.

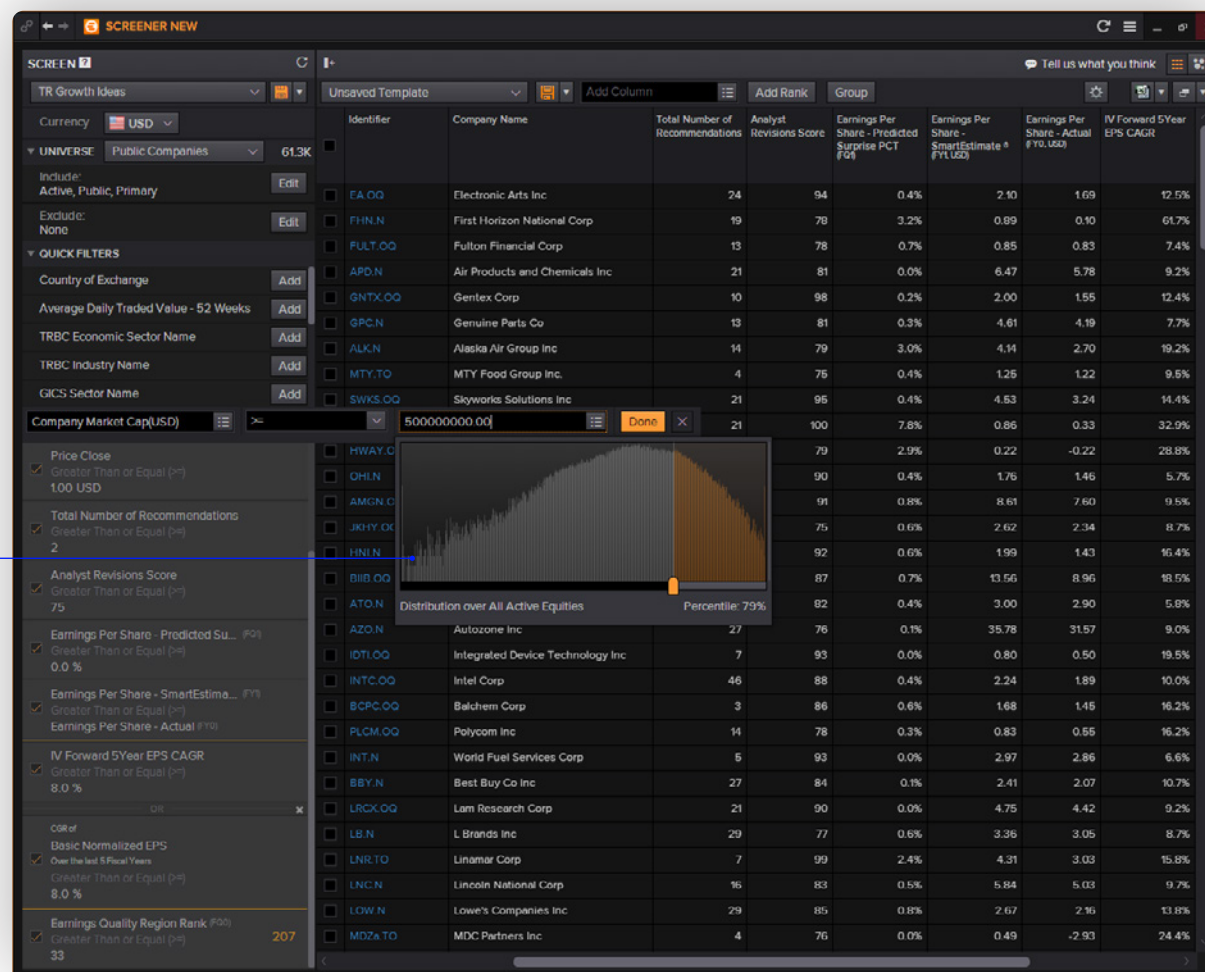


Screening for ideas

To access, type **SCREENER** and follow the **Get started** tips

- Screen across a global universe of 60,000 companies against 6,000 data items, including industry-specific performance indicators and custom expressions. You can also screen across 3.9 million private companies
- Select data items from Refinitiv® Financials, I/B/E/S Estimates and unique content sources like StarMine Quantitative Analytics
- Perform basic data analysis such as sorting, grouping and aggregation using a data table, and visualize the data using a scatter plot
- You can also save screens and set them as your favorites
- Export your screening results to Excel and save as a list
- A multifactor ranking capability with drilldowns helps you understand which factors contribute most to overall rank

View and select data ranges in visual histograms to easily adjust.



Macro Explorer

To access, type **Macro Explorer** or **MACROX**

- The Macro Explorer app offers compelling macroeconomic data visualization features to help you identify investment opportunities
- This intuitive app offers highly interactive market selection filters that allow you to:
 - Access hundreds of indicators to gain historical insight across markets
 - Screen for markets that meet a wide range of performance or risk criteria
 - View natural language-generated insights with contextualized summaries of the data in view
 - Display an interactive sector heat map with dozens of aggregate fundamentals available to choose from
 - Search for deeper trends and multiple indicator comparisons using moving grids and scatter plots
 - Visualize the real-time performance of your watch lists, portfolios and a selection of cross-asset benchmarks on our world map view
 - Navigate to country overview pages for further investigation
 - Export data to Excel for further analysis

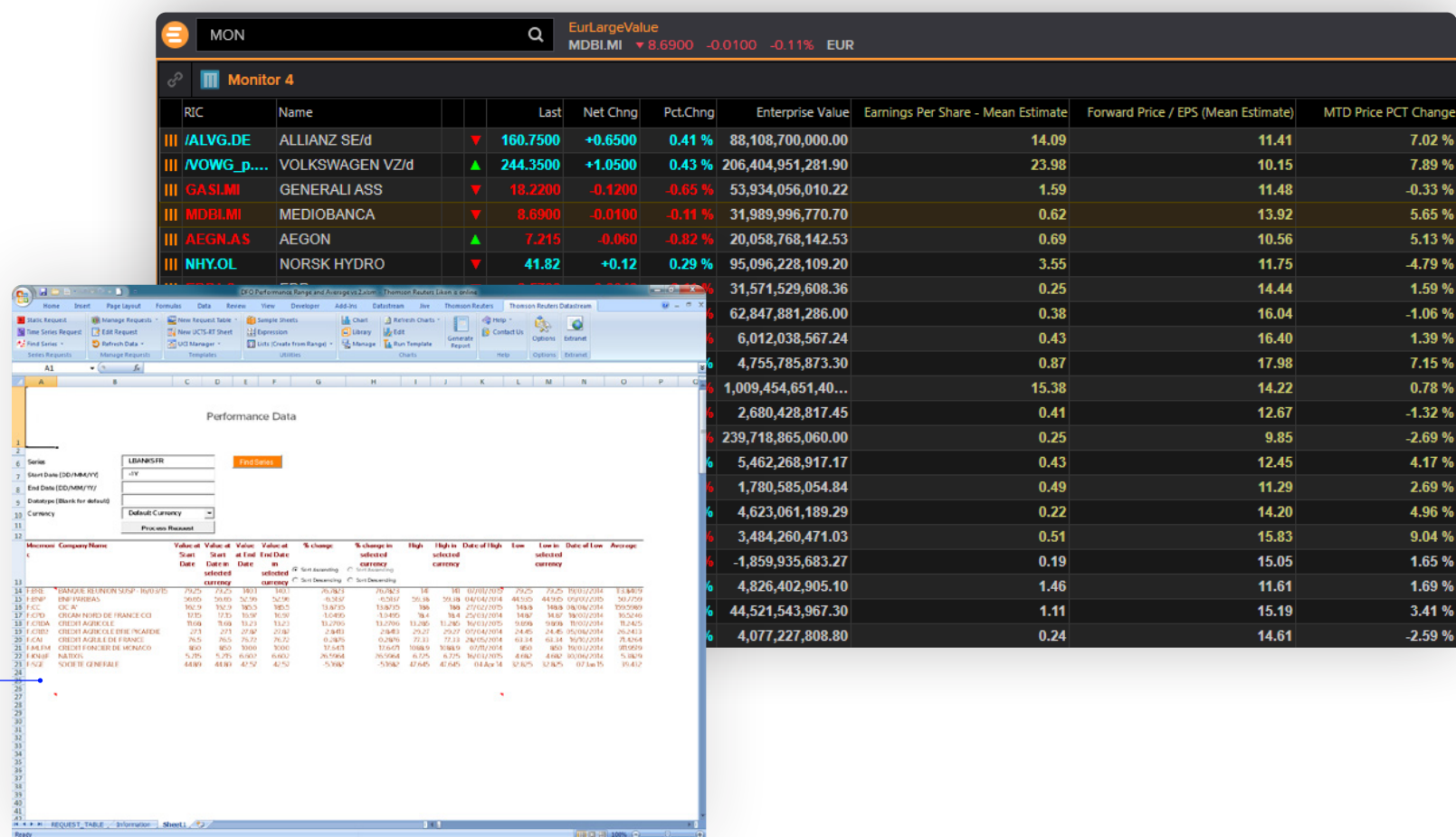

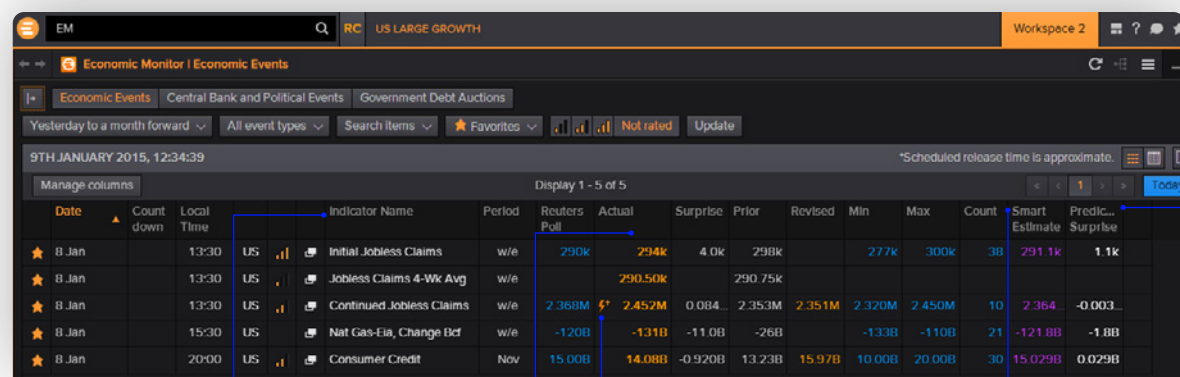

- Access items in Excel using the performance data sample sheet in DFO, or build your own data requests using Datastream's function and expression tools



Economic Monitor

To access, type in **ECON MONITOR** or **EM**

- Track all global macroeconomic indicator updates in a simple calendar interface
- Easily set up calendar updates in Microsoft Outlook and create alerts for all economic events
- Quickly compare and contrast results with consensus estimates to identify market-moving positive/negative surprises
- Reuters economic polls allow you to track market expectations covering foreign exchange rates, macroeconomic indicators, interest rates, asset allocation, and commodities and energy instruments – providing a context for developing your own economic and market scenarios
- 1,300 real-time economic indicators covered across 49 countries, plus euro area and EU aggregates



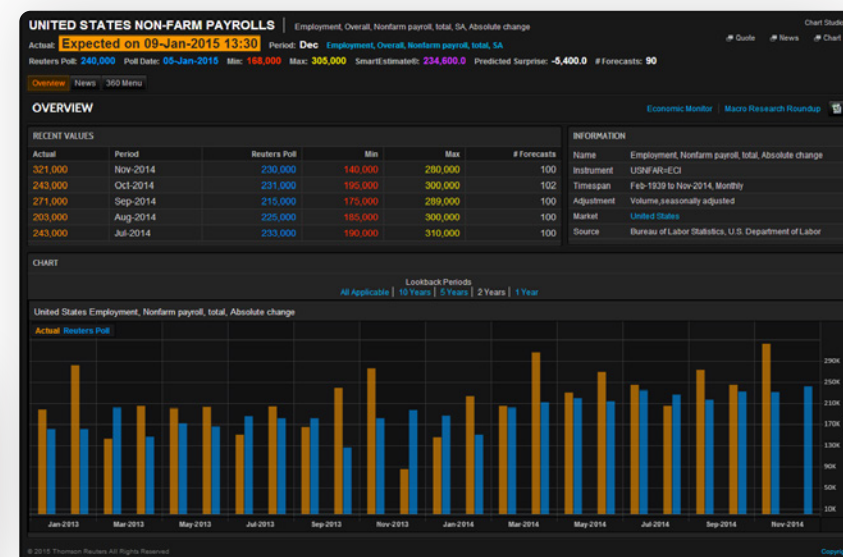



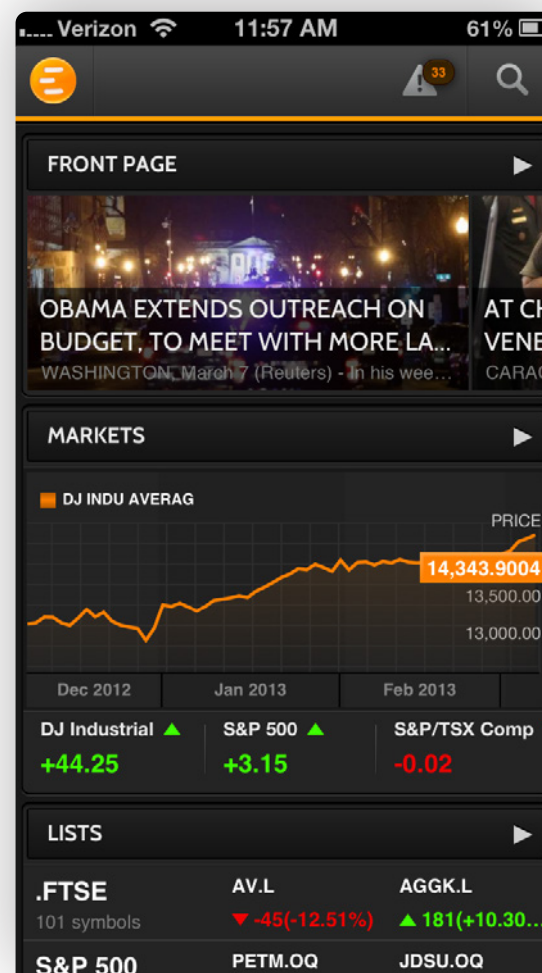
